



The Coventry Pilgrimage Record Sheet

The Coventry Pilgrimage was established as a celebration of the 100th anniversary of the Diocese of Coventry. Essentially it circles the area generally following the Coventry Way but incorporating as many churches as possible. It ends at Coventry Cathedral. This sheet is set out in the stages that were walked at the time. At noon there was a pause to say the Litany of Reconciliation in unity with the cathedral (words in the guide book) Please follow the appropriate guide for directions. Also note that many churches may not be open.
